Key facts to learn:

- The letter 'h' is silent (unless the word is not of Spanish origin)
- The multiples of ten and how to use this knowledge to give different ages
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Key skills to do:

- Recall the multiples of 10 in Spanish
- Ask someone the name of their mother/father and give an appropriate reply when asked.
- Explain how old someone else is.
- Embed five of the key sound patterns/phonemes: CA CE CI CO CU to aid pronunciation.
