



Spanish KCV – La Fecha – The date



Key facts to learn:

- Months of the year and days of the week do not have a capital letter in Spanish unless they are at the start of sentence.
- When writing a question in Spanish, an upside-down question mark is used at the start of the question.

Key skills to do:

- Recall the numbers 1 – 31 in Spanish
- Learn the Spanish vocabulary for the 12 months of the year.
- In Spanish, write the question ‘When is your birthday’ using correct punctuation.
- How to say when our birthday is using the days of the week months of the year and the numbers 1 -31.
- Embed five of the key sound patterns/phonemes: GA GE GI GO GU to aid pronunciation.
