Words to understand and spell (Tier 3 Vocabulary)

Live Ball	A 'live' ball is one that has not bounced or hit a wall or ceiling.
End Zone	The areas at the back of the court where players must stand at the start of the game.
Target	Any 'live' player on the opposing team.
Dead Zone	The area that runs through the centre of the court. Only a players hands are allowed in the dead zone.
Officiate	Act as an official or referee.
Sportsmanship	Fair and generous behaviour or treatment of others.
