## Words to understand and spell (Tier 3 Vocabulary)

<b>Interception</b>	Catching a pass made by an opposing player.
<b>Rebound</b>	When a player attempts to shoot a goal but the ball hits the goalpost and bounces back into play.
<b>Conceding</b>	Another team scoring.
<b>Consecutive</b>	One after another
<b>Consistently</b>	Doing the same thing correctly multiple times.
