Spring is seen as the season that welcomes new life in nature.

Easter is a special time for Christians. Christians believe Jesus came to show God's love so they try to show love to others.

Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey. - Some people were really excited to see Jesus because they thought He was going to rescue them from the Romans who had taken over their country. They wanted to make Jesus king. They waved palm leaves and shouted 'hosanna!'

The Last Supper - Jesus shared a meal with his disciples. They ate bread and wine.

The Garden of Gethsemane - Jesus and His disciples prayed.

Christians believe Jesus was God's son so He was asking God for help because he knew something scary was going to happen.

Judas kissed Jesus to show the soldiers who to arrest.
