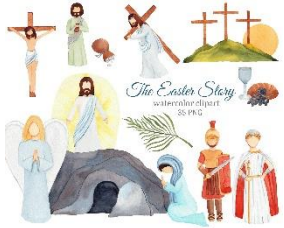


Y1/2 Subject: RE – Easter, Palm Sunday



The Easter Story

Why are we learning about Incarnation?



We are building on our previous learning of the teachings and beliefs of God and Jesus around sacrifice and celebrations.

Based on our previous learning, we are going to learn and ask the question 'Why is Jesus special to Christians?' We will also be evaluating how the welcome of Jesus on Palm Sunday shows this.

It is important to know why Christians value of celebrations and the sacrifice Jesus made.

This will be developed in Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3 and 4) where we ask how Sikhs and other religions value sharing and the community.

Important questions to answer:



- Who is an important person to you?
- What would you say to Jesus to welcome him?
- Why would you welcome Jesus in a certain way?
- What is the Easter story?
- How does the Easter story symbolise sacrifice but hope.

Experiences we will have:



- Share and reflect who is special to us

Things we need to know:



- I know that love can determine if someone is special to me
- I know that the Easter story represents the Jewish Passover when he gave his life as a sacrifice.
- I know that Palm Sunday is a reminder to welcome Jesus into their hearts and to be willing to follow him.

Skills we need to learn:



- I can talk about who is important to me
- I can sequence the Easter story
- I explain the meaning of Palm Sunday
- I can discuss how I would welcome Jesus
