## Why are we learning about Christianity - Salvation? 📽

It is important to know the Christian view of salvation and eternity because the belief in salvation underpins many Christian beliefs. In a country where Christianity is still the most common religion, having a good understanding of this is helpful in order to be able to show tolerance and make our own decisions about faith.

### Important questions to answer:



- Does anything last forever?
- What does the Bible teach about eternity?
- What do Christians believe about love and forgiveness?
- How do Christians believe you get to heaven?
- What is the Christian belief about eternal life?

#### Things we need to know:



- To know the opinions of our classmates about whether anything lasts forever
- To know bible verses and passages about eternity and what they mean, such as John 3:16 and John 14:2
- To know that Christians believe in love and forgiveness and how it applies to their lives
- To know how Christians believe you get to heaven through believing that Jesus was a sacrifice for their sins, based on the teachings of the bible
- To know what Christians believe that anyone who trusts Jesus as Lord receives eternal life

- I can explore and explain what the bible teaches about eternity
- I can **discover** how the Christian values of love and forgiveness are applied
- I can **explain** how Christians believe you get to heaven
